
- Route directions are given, ONLY when the answer to the next clue is NOT within sight. All clues can be seen from public locations.

Take the footpath opposite Peapod Cottage towards Charney Playing Field

Exit Charney Playing Field down the bridlepath towards the phonebox (now defibrillator)		
7	There are many triangular manhole covers in the village. Which birds appear in these marshes?	
Walk towards the Church

9	According to information in the Church why was the year 1322 notable?	
10	Where are the griffins (or are they dragons?) in the Church?	
11	According to the sign at the road entrance to Charney Manor, what is the description of "Quakers"?	
12	What is the building opposite the Manor Entrance?	
Retrace your steps back towards Millennium Orchard		
13	<p>Where is this photograph taken from?</p> 	
Walk towards The Chequers		
14	Charney Bassett's Golden Jubilee Oak is from which "country"?	
Continue towards The Chequers
